

Study Hall

First Day of Study Hall: September 6, 2016

NO STUDY HALL: December 21, 2016 or March 9, 2017

Last Day of Study Hall: June 6, 2017

Study hall is a designated time and place to complete assignments and homework. It is a quiet learning environment for students to develop good work habits and inquire help when needed by the professional facilitator/teacher.

This is a complimentary service provided by St. Maria Goretti to increase learning amongst our student population. We feel this service in an incredible advantage for our students and we want to see it utilized to its full potential.

Study hall is offered to students grades K to grade 8. If you wish to have your student attend Study Hall every day, a few days a week, or once a month please complete the registration form. Students may only attend study hall if the attached form is completed. If your child is not registered than your child will need to go to Daycare and you will be charged the appropriate fee.

Students must be in Study Hall no later than 3:05pm. Students are asked to stay the duration. Students should have all the materials and supplies they will need in order to complete assignments. Students will not be permitted to go back and forth to various classrooms to get the items they need. Students should come to Study Hall prepared and ready to work. If a student needs to leave early the parent must go to the classroom to request the early dismissal.

Students must be picked up on time or they will be checked into daycare and charged accordingly. Grades K-5 <u>3:30pm</u> Grades 6-8 <u>3:45pm</u>

If your child does not have homework they will be instructed to silently read. If you wish to provide your child with work to complete independently that would be allowed as well. If your child becomes distracted due to lack of work and becomes a behavior problem they will be sent to daycare and fees will apply.
